**DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT:** A deposit of \$250 per passenger should be sent with a completed Travelrite International booking form that lists your requested cabin category. As soon as the booking is confirmed, (usually within 24 hours), a cruise confirmation advice will be posted to the client. The confirmation advice will contain all details. Final payments are due to be paid to Travelrite International 90 days prior to the commencement of the cruise. A 1.5% administration fee applies to payments by credit card.
