The lunar landscape of the Giant's Causeway is a World Heritage site where the basalt columns packed tightly together have made the Giant's Causeway the subject of numerous legends. After a brief stop at the Titanic Dry Dock, we return to the city of Belfast for a sightseeing tour where we will see City Hall, the Grand Opera House, Queens University and Albert Memorial Clock.



DAY 9 Monday 18 August, 2025

Liverpool, England

This morning we arrive into the port city of Liverpool, the capital city in the county of Lancashire, a city full of culture, excitement and important maritime history, and famous for its Mersey waterfront. Liverpool is also known throughout the world for being the home of The Beatles, at the time when the Mersey Beat was born. On our sightseeing tour we will see Matthew Street, the home of the Cavern Club where The Beatles played. We will make our way down to the Mersey waterfront and take a ferry ride across the River Mersey, made famous by Jerry & The Pacemakers.
